ENTRY DETAILS

- Entry fees: £12 for individual Kata or Kumite. £20.00 to enter BOTH categories.
- Competition categories are open to:
 - Juniors: 6 years to 15 years
 - Seniors: 16 years +
- **Closing date / DEADLINE** for receipt of entry forms is **FRIDAY 16TH OCTOBER 2015**. Entries can only be submitted **by EMAIL to events@jka-england.org** by a club chief instructor or club representative. Once the entries are received, they will be checked and **AN EMAIL SENT BACK TO THE CLUB CONFIRMING BOTH RECEIPT OF ENTRY AND THE TOTAL ENTRY FEE THAT WILL BE PAYABLE**. This is so that clubs can submit payment for the correct amount and are assured their entry has been received. However, competitors will still only be entered if the **payment** has been **received by Monday 26th October 2015**.
- The **age and / or grade** of a competitor must be as of the closing date for entries – Friday 16th October 2015 and **not** the date of the championships.
- JKA England members do NOT require a disclaimer.
- All **other** competitors **MUST** complete and sign a disclaimer. Disclaimers should be submitted by email with the entry forms with under 16's having consent from a parent or guardian.
- When submitting competitor entries, a club is required to nominate an individual who, on the day of the Championships, will act as their coach and be responsible for registering their members and collecting the competitor entry numbers, labels and details.
