ENTRY DETAILS

- Competition categories are open to:
 - Juniors: 6 years to 15 years
 - Seniors: 16 years +
- Entries can only be submitted by email to events@jka-england.org by a club chief instructor or club representative.
- **Payment** has to be **received by Monday 19th June 2017 or cash on the day if arranged in advance with the Events officer.**
- The **age and / or grade** of a competitor must be as of the closing date for entries – Friday 9th June 2017 and **not** the date of the championships.
- Entrants and their Club's Chief Instructor must hold a valid JKA England Membership Licence on the day of the Championships (which they may be asked to produce) and belong to a currently affiliated JKA England Club. Any queries relating to current membership can be made at membership@jka-england.org.
- Any student who has attended a regional, national or international course during 2016/17 has already completed a disclaimer that is valid for **all** events in 2017. All **other** competitors are required to complete and sign a disclaimer. Disclaimers must be submitted with the entry forms with under 16's having consent from a parent or guardian. Please photocopy disclaimers as necessary to fulfil your requirements.
- When submitting entries, each club is required to nominate an individual who, on the day of the Championships, will act as their coach and be responsible for registering their members and collecting the competitor entry numbers, labels and details.
